

Since the last Guam Census of Agriculture in 2018, the amount of land in farms, the value of agricultural products sold, and the number of farms increased. Both the number of small farms and the number of larger farms increased.

What is a "farm"? The Guam Census of Agriculture defines a farm as any place from which \$1,000 or more of agricultural products were produced and sold, or normally would have been sold, during the census year.

Farms and Land

In 2023, Guam had 583 farms, an increase of 319 farms since 2018. These farms accounted for 2,848 acres of farmland, or 2.1% of all land in Guam. This was an increase of 407 acres (17%) from the 2018 level.

During the same time, the average farm size decreased 47%, from 9.2 acres in 2018 to 4.9 acres in 2023.
