NASS periodically conducts a program review for the Floriculture program. The primary purpose is to ensure that the NASS annual estimating program targets crops and states most relevant based on the latest available information.

The primary source of information for the program review is the Census of Horticultural Specialties.

States included in the estimating program for floriculture.

Total floriculture sales from the 2014 Census of Horticultural Specialties were arrayed from largest to smallest. States that account for the largest proportion of the total were identified for inclusion in the annual estimating program. This allows us to provide the most useful data to the agricultural sector in the most efficient means possible given the limited available resources.

Floriculture crop sales data from the 2014 Census of Horticultural Specialties were arrayed from largest to smallest within each crop category (Annual Bedding Plants, Cut Flowers, Heraceous Perennials, Potted Flowering Plants, Foliage Plants, and Cut Cultivated Greens). Crops that account for the largest proportion of the total were identified for inclusion in the annual estimating program. This allows us to provide the most useful data to the agricultural sector in the most efficient means possible given the limited available resources.
